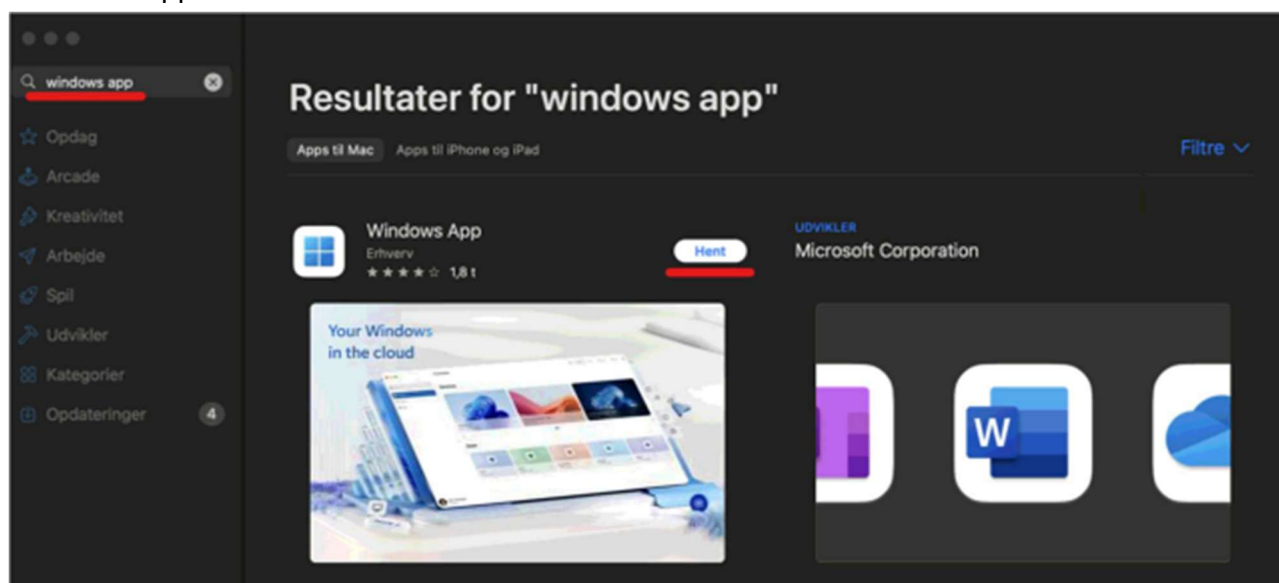


Connection to Research Servers at DST – Mac

This guide describes how to connect to the researcher servers at Statistics Denmark – this applies to both hosted and shared servers.

Before connecting, you must install the "Windows App" from the App Store. Gå til App Store og søg efter "Windows APP"

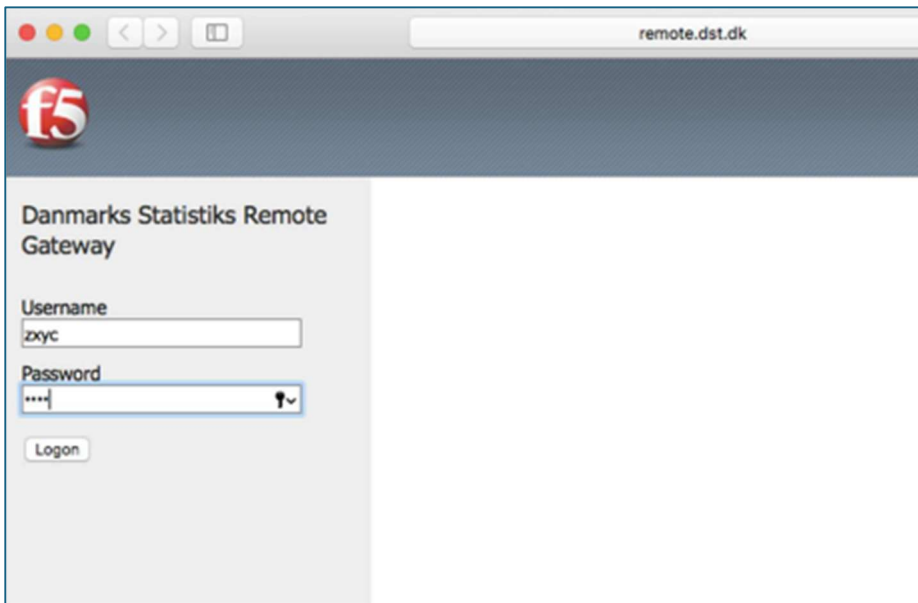
Select the application and Install



Connection to the servers

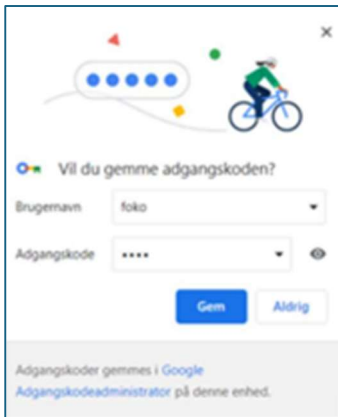
1. Open your preferred browser (e.g., Chrome, Safari...)
2. Enter the address <https://remote.dst.dk>

3. The page looks like this:

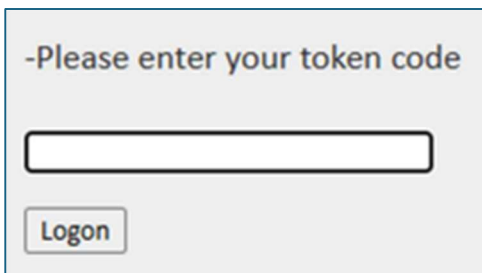


4. Enter your ID as the "Username" (e.g., FXXX)
5. Enter your PIN for remote.dst.dk as the "Password".
6. Click "Logon"

If the following appears on the screen, click "Never".

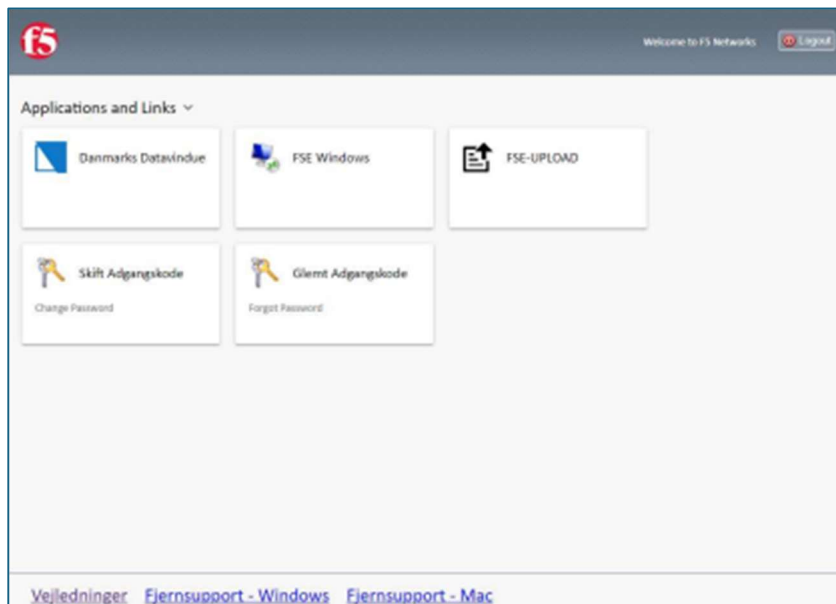


7. Next, the page asks for your token code:



8. Open FortiToken Mobile on your phone and enter the 6-digit code displayed in the app.

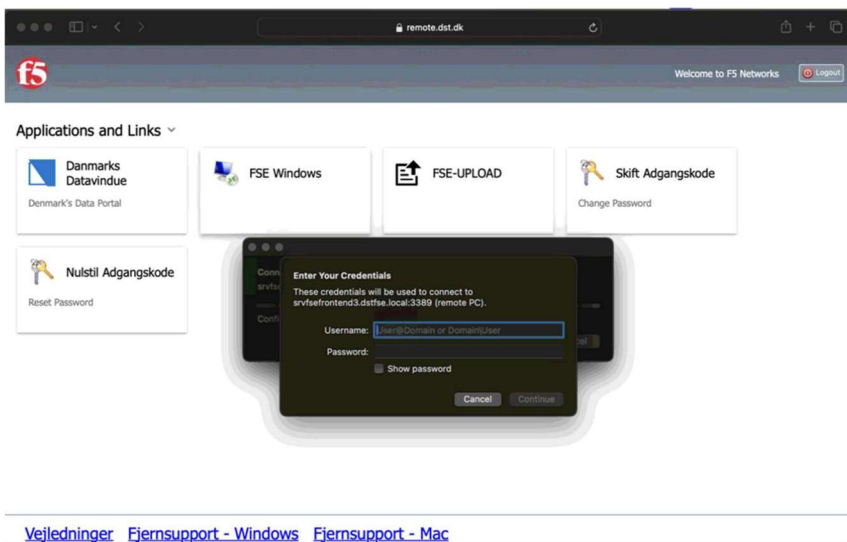
9. Click "Logon"
10. After logging in, you will be able to see the buttons you have access to.



11. Click on the server you want to connect to.
12. Click "Allow"



13. Then enter your project ID as the "Username" for the server
14. (e.g., dstfse\foko709999 or foko709999@dstfse.local)



15. Enter your password as the "Password" for the user.
16. The following appears the first time you log in to the server.

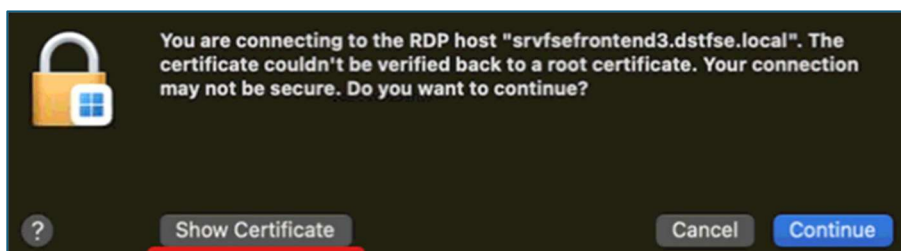
17. Enter username and password

The username can be entered in the following way:

- a. DSTFSE\<projektident>
- b. <projektident>@dstfse.local

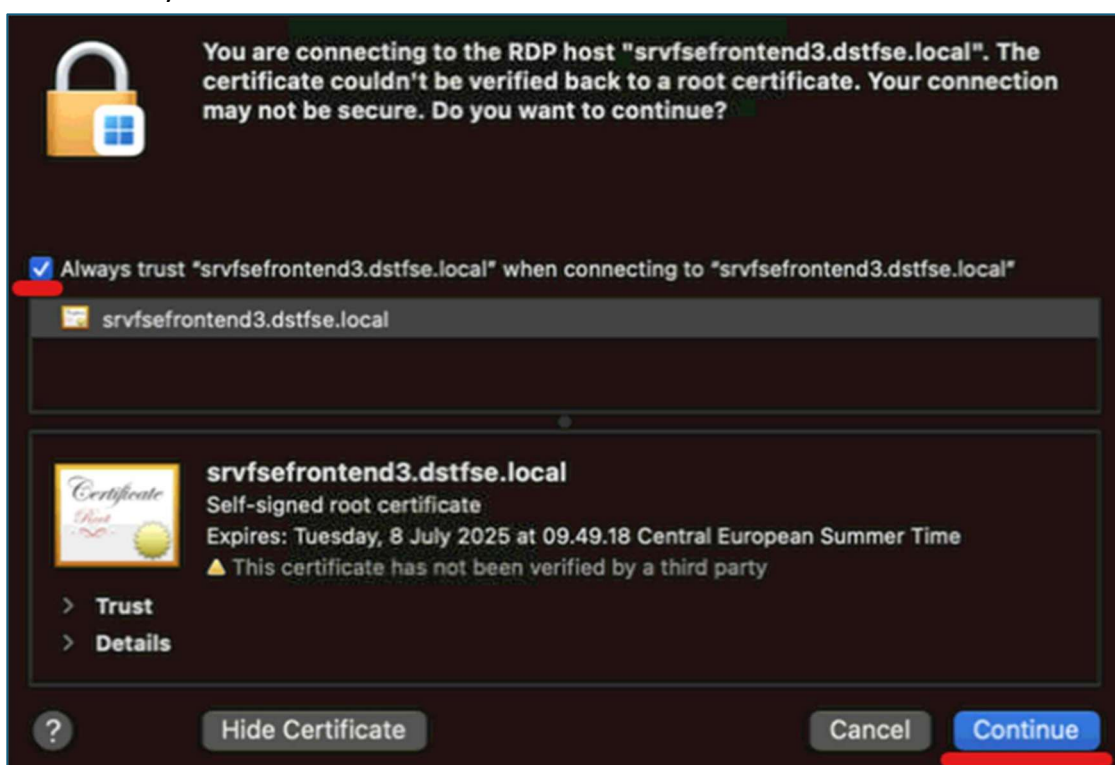
Important: Do not check "Remember my credentials," as you will encounter problems later when changing your password. Klik på "OK"

18. You will then see the following warning:



Click "Show Certificate"

19. Check "Always trust ... when connection to ..."



20. Click "Continue"

21. Enter the username and password for your Mac.



22. You will then be connected to the server.

Then you have finished your work on the server, it is good practice to log off properly.

You will see a "Logoff" button on the server's desktop.



Use it to log off when you have finished your work.

Note: If you use the "X" in the top bar, you disconnect the remote session but do not log off. Any programs you have open will remain open the next time you log in, and any issues with those programs will persist when you reconnect to the server.

In addition, you must log out of remote.dst.dk by clicking "Logout" in the top left corner.
