

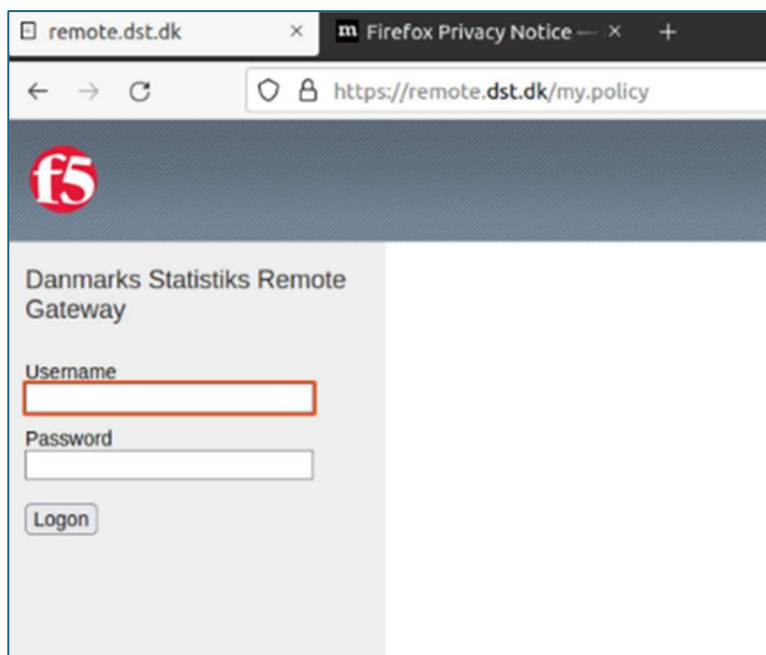
## Connection to the research servers at DST - Linux

This guide describes how to connect to the researcher servers at Statistics Denmark – this applies to both hosted and shared servers.

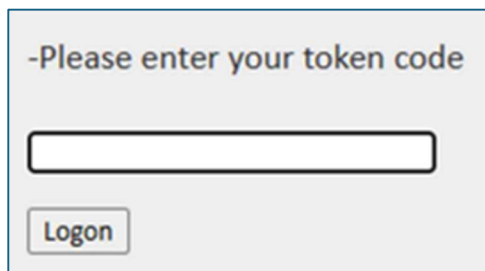
The screenshots in the guide are from a freshly installed Ubuntu 20.04.4 LTS system. No additional settings or programs have been installed. The **Remmina** application is already installed in this version of Ubuntu; if **Remmina** is not installed, you must install it before proceeding.

### Connect to the servers

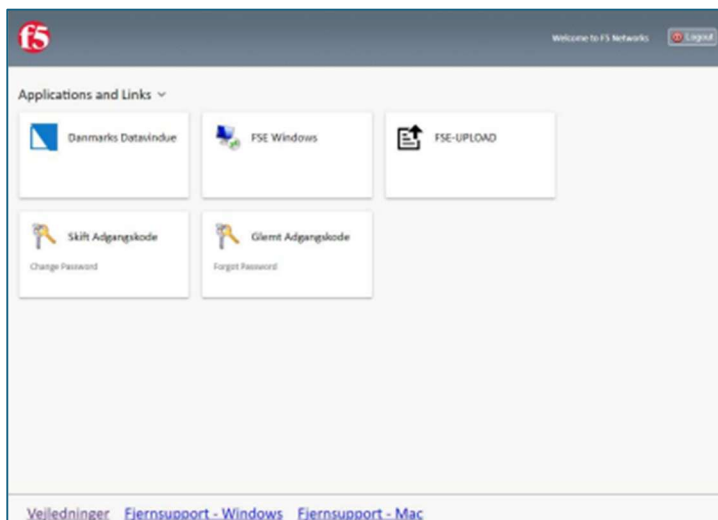
1. Open your preferred browser (e.g. Firefox, Chrome...)
2. Enter the url: <https://remote.dst.dk>
3. The site looks like this:



4. Enter your Username (e.g. FXXX)
5. Enter your PIN for remote.dst.dk as the "Password".
6. Click "Logon"
7. The page then asks for your token code.



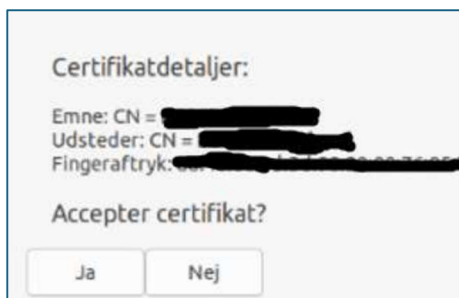
8. Open FortiToken Mobile on your phone and enter the 6-digit code displayed in the app.
9. Click "Logon"
10. After logging in, you will be able to see the buttons you have access to.



11. Click on the server you want to connect to.
12. Click on the file being downloaded.



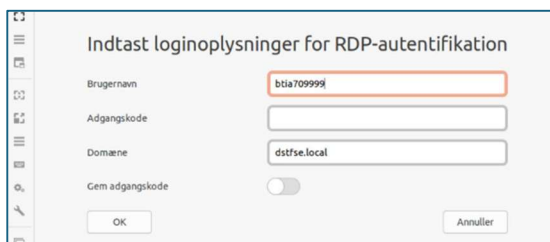
13. Approve the certificate by pressing "Ja/Yes".



14. Then enter your project ID for the server as the "Username".  
Enter "dstfse" as the "Domain".

**Important: Do not check "Remember my credentials," as you will encounter problems later when changing your password.**

15. Also enter your password and click "OK".



The username is the one you use for the project you wish to access. It consists of 3–4 letters followed by 4–6 digits. For example, BTI709999.

16. You will then be logged into the server and can begin your work.

When you have finished your work on the server, it is good practice to log off properly. On the desktop of the server you will be able to see a "Logoff" button.



Use it to log off when you have finished your work.

**Note: If you simply close the window you disconnect the remote session but do not log off. Any programs you have open will remain open the next time you log in, and any issues with those programs will persist when you reconnect to the server.**

In addition, you must log out of remote.dst.dk by clicking "Logout" in the top left corner.
