Submission of data to International trade in services

Important information

- The data submitted covers **the purchases and sales of services of Danish enterprises** with foreign counterparts as well as purchases and sales of specific goods, which do not cross the Danish border.
- All reported trade must be defined using **country and service codes**. You can download code lists here: www.dst.dk/tjenester-en
- The data must be **submitted in Danish kroner** (DKK).
